



VECTOR OUTBOARDS

"Affordable power for your time afloat"

- This warranty applies to outboard motors purchased from an authorized outboard dealer on or after 1st January 2012.
- This warranty covers the required repairing expense of your outboard motor as a result of defects in materials or workmanship during the Period of Warranty, when maintained and utilized in the prescribed manner.
- This warranty specifies the warranty coverage and notes your responsibilities in maintaining and operating your outboard. Please take time to read and become familiar with this warranty.

PERIOD OF WARRANTY

- Any new outboard motor purchased and registered with the outboard distributor for pleasure use will be warranted against defects in material or workmanship for a period of FIVE (5) years from the date of purchase, subject to exclusions noted herein.
- Peripheral equipment included with the motor, such as gauges, fuel tanks and hoses, propellers, remote control boxes, and wiring external from the motor unit, will be warranted for one (1) year from the date of purchase for pleasure use. Replacement parts used in warranty repairs will be warranted for the balance of the applicable warranty period.
- Any new outboard motor purchased and registered with the outboard distributor for commercial applications will be warranted for a period of one (1) year from the date of purchase.
- The warranty shall be limited to cover the cost of parts and labor for the following major components only:

- Power unit

- engine section
 - reed valve and intake manifold
 - carburettor assembly and related components
 - fuel and oil pump
 - oil injection system
 - ignition system
- 2. Bracket section
 - bracket including steering system
- 3. Lower unit section
 - exhaust system
 - upper casing
 - lower unit assembly

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

- To be eligible for warranty coverage, the outboard motor must be registered with the outboard distributor.
- A Warranty Registration Form is provided in this book with each outboard. This form must be completed by the selling dealer at the time of purchase and filed with the distributor.

PRE-DELIVERY CHECK

- The warranty remains void if the pre-delivery check has not been completed by an authorized manufacturer outboard dealer.

OBTAINING REPAIRS UNDER WARRANTY

- To receive repairs under this warranty, the unit specified herein must be returned to an authorized manufacturer outboard dealer.
- This book with Warranty Registration Form must be presented to an authorized manufacturer's dealer.
 - During the Period of Warranty any authorized manufacturer outboard dealer will, free of charge, repair or replace at manufacturer's option, any parts judged defective by manufacturer due to faulty workmanship or material from the factory. All replaced parts will become the property of the manufacturer distributor.

PURCHASER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Under the terms of this warranty, the customer will be responsible for ensuring that the outboard motor is properly operated and maintained periodically by an authorized manufacturer outboard dealer.
- The customer shall give notice to a manufacturer-authorized outboard dealer of any and all apparent defects within ten (10) days of discovery. The customer shall make the motor available at that time for inspection repairs by the authorized manufacturer outboard dealer. Repair shall be conducted only with the authorized manufacturer outboard dealer.

GENERAL EXCLUSIONS FROM WARRANTY

This warranty will not cover the repair of damage if the damage is a result of misuse, abuse or neglect of the product. Examples of abuse and neglect include, but are not limited to:

- The outboard altered from standard.
 - Racing or competitive activity; modification of original pads; abnormal use;
- Careless and improper transportation, lack of proper maintenance and off-season storage as described in the Owner's Manual, improper service or mounting of motor, installation of pads or accessories that are not equivalent in design and quality to genuine pads;
- Damage caused by water entering engine cylinder(s) through exhaust system or carburettor(s);
- Operation of the motor at an rpm other than specified, improper propeller selection, use of fuel, lubricants & oils, and fuel/oil mixtures that are not suitable for outboard motor use and contaminated fuel;
- Damages caused by failure to follow the procedures and recommendations as contained in the Owner's Manual. The warranty becomes void if periodical maintenance is not performed;
- Damage caused by failure of any parts caused by lack of cooling water, which results from starting outboard motor out of water, foreign material blocking inlet holes, motor being mounted too high or trimmed too far out;
 - Damage caused by cosmetic paint changes due to exposure to the elements;
 - Damage caused by growth of marine organisms on motor or motor surfaces;

- Failure of damage as result of corrosion caused by stray current or outside galvanic activity;
 - Normal wear and tear.

This warranty will not cover the routine service adjustments including but not limited to minor adjustments and tune ups, including checking, cleaning, replacing or adjusting spark plugs, ignition components, carburettor settings, filters, belts, controls and checking lubrication made in connection with normal routine services, engine and lower unit oil changes, valve and linkage adjustments, replacement of fuses, anodes, thermostats, timing belts and propellers.

This warranty will not cover the following expenses, which shall be borne by the purchaser:

- Haul-out, launching, towing or trailering, storage, telephone or rental charge of any type during warranty service;
 - Removal of the motor from the boat and reinstallation;
- Transportation of the motor to and from the authorized manufacturer's outboard dealer.
- Removal and/or replacement of boat partitions or material because of boat design for necessary access to the product.

This warranty will not apply to any consequential loss, damages, injury or expense arising out of any defect of any nature in any outboard or part thereof or in connection with the fulfillment of any obligation under this warranty.

SPECIFIC PARTS EXCLUDED FROM WARRANTY

Parts replaced due to normal wear or routine maintenance such as oil/spark plugs, shear pins, propellers, hubs, gaskets seals, cables, fuel and oil filters, brushes for the starter motor and power tilt motor, water pump parts, anodes, electric components (other than ignition system), and rubber components (such as hoses/tubes, rubber seals, fittings, and clamps) are not covered by warranty.

TRANSFER OF WARRANTY

This will apply to products for pleasure use only.

- Transfer of the warranty from the original purchaser to any subsequent purchaser is possible by having the motor inspected by an authorized manufacturer outboard dealer and requesting the dealer to submit a change of registration to the distributor within ten (10) days of the transfer.
- In the case of transfer the Period of Warranty is started from the date of the first purchase so that it is the balance of warranty that is transferred over to the second purchaser.
- Transfer of warranty is not applicable to commercial users. The warranty stays with the first purchaser for three (3) months only.

We reserve the right to improve the design of any product without assuming any obligation to modify any product previously manufactured.

All incidental and/or consequential loss or damages are excluded from this warranty. Warranties of merchantability and fitness are excluded from this warranty. Implied warranties are limited to the life of this warranty.

This warranty does not affect the non-excludable statutory rights of the consumer, but is in addition to those rights.

WARRANTY Q&A

Q. What are the pleasure application and commercial application?

- A. ● A pleasure unit is any unit that the purchaser uses for personal enjoyment only and does not intend to use for profit purpose
- A commercial unit is any unit that the purchaser used for the purpose other than pleasure. (Outboards which are used periodically for both pleasure and commercial use will be classified as commercial use.)

Q. What costs are my responsibility during the warranty period?

A. The customer's responsibility includes all costs of normal maintenance services, non-warranty repairs, and accident and collision damages.

Q. What are some examples of "abnormal" strain, neglect, or abuse?

A. These terms are general and overlap each other in areas. Specific examples include: Running the machine out of oil, operating the machine with a broken or damaged part which causes another part to fail, damage or failure due to improper or careless transportation. If you have any specific questions on operation or maintenance, please contact your outboard dealer.

Q. What are some examples of causes for damage due to water entering engines cylinders through exhaust system or carburetors?

A.

- The outboard sitting too deep in the water, especially when the boat is stationary;
- Launching and retrieving the boat with a trailer;
- Improper mounting of the motor;
- Water contaminated fuel;
- Submersion

Q. Does the warranty cover incidental costs such as towing or transportation due to a failure?

A. No. The warranty is limited to repair of the machine itself at the authorized manufacturer outboard dealer.

Q. What responsibility does an outboard dealer have under this warranty?

A. Each outboard dealer is expected to:

- Completely set up each outboard he sells prior to delivery
- Explain the operation, maintenance, and warranty requirements to your satisfaction at the time of sale, and upon your request at any later date. In addition, each outboard dealer is held responsible for his setup, service and warranty repair work.

Q. Is the warranty transferable to second owners?

A. Yes. However, this will apply to unit used for pleasure applications only. The remainder of existing warranty can be transferred upon request. The outboard motor has to be inspected and re-registered by an authorized manufacturer outboard dealer for the policy to remain effective.
